Hello Graysdale neighbors!

A few weeks ago, you each received an email inviting you to vote on a single issue related to the need to approve sheds in our neighborhood. Then a week later, you would have received a reminder to do so if you hadn't voted already.

The survey question read as follows (with simple "Yes" and "No" response options):

I vote in favor of allowing sheds that are less than 42 square feet in size and that are placed against the home or on a patio/deck to be exempt from our Homeowners Association guidelines (see http://www.graysdale.com/covenants/GraysdaleShedGuidelines_15April2009.pdf). Sheds that meet these specifications will be allowed without prior approval of the Graysdale Homeowners Association Board.

I am writing to let you know the results of this vote. After removing "duplicate" votes (only one vote was allowed per household), there were 15 "No" votes and 63 "Yes" votes. So sheds of 42 square feet in size or less that are placed against the home or on a patio/deck will no longer need HOA board approval.
