RECYCLING NEWS!

Did you know that you can now put "paperboard" out with your recycling? Here is the announcement from the COG Web site:

"Beginning January 2, 2009 the Centre County Solid Waste Authority is adding paperboard to its recycling program. Veolia curbside customers are asked to recycle paperboard along with their mixed paper. Please place the paperboard products and mixed paper in a paper or plastic bag next to or in your curbside recycling bin. Paperboard items that may be recycled include, but are not limited to:

- cereal boxes
- gift boxes
- paper towel rolls
- tablet backs
- cracker boxes
- toilet paper rolls
- shoe boxes
- spaghetti boxes
- tissue boxes

Paperboard products should NOT be placed with corrugated cardboard. Paperboard should be recycled with mixed paper."

And if you notice a problem with a street light, please report it directly to Allegheny Power (they'll need to know the number of the post from the label on it).
